Tennis Court Rules

The Tennis Courts are for the use and enjoyment of SouthWood Owners, permitted residents, and their guests. The following rules are designed to ensure the enjoyment for all and they must be observed at all times.

1. Players should wear appropriate tennis attire. Shirts and tennis shoes are required. No street shoes are allowed.
2. NO motorcycle, bicycles, skates, skateboards, roller blades, scooters or any other vehicles allowed on the courts.
3. NO pets or alcoholic beverages allowed.
4. Observers should remain outside the courts.
5. When courts are full, play should be limited to one (1) hour.
6. Players should show courtesy to players on other courts. Do not cross through courts during play. No horseplay or profanity.
7. These courts are to be used for recreational play and for programs and activities approved by the SouthWood Residential Community Association. Play may be limited or the courts may be closed during special events.
8. Please keep the courts clean. Deposit trash in appropriate receptacles.
9. The SouthWood Residential Community Association reserves the right to impose a reservation system without prior notice.
